

Course description

 This subject consists theoretical knowledge and practical skills in various laboratory practices related to cell culture techniques (in vitro) and animal experimentation (in vivo), utilization of microscopes (compound microscope, stereo microscope, etc.), special staining techniques for differentiation, molecular diagnostics techniques, serological immunoassays and health geographic information system. Students will develop skills in research, communication, experimentation, data utilization, presentation of experimental results, and report writing. Research ethics will also be emphasized.
